Budget Parameters

Maintain the value of the HOA

Keep up with inflation, there are some items out of our control and these increases have to be met.

Open Issues

- Fiscal year revision ~ we are resetting our Fiscal Year to October 1 through September 30. This will result in a 3 month addition to our current Fiscal Year.
- Earthquake Insurance, we have received a quote and the bid is being reviewed
- Water line replacement plan ~ the engineering portion is complete and the next step is to obtain 3 bids. The target start date for the actual work to begin is May 2020.
- Security Sheriff contract has changed we can no longer have a dedicated Sheriff so we need to decide how we are going to deal with these changes so we have set up a special town hall meeting March 30th 10:00 am

- Additional street lights, improve security, add more cameras
- Second reader board at TL entrance
- Power to Island Park, improve boat launch on the big lake, stock more fish!
- Do more goose population control
- Update the MPC improve curb-appeal/landscaping, activity space, add conference room, increase the office space
- Steeper wage trend for office/maintenance staff for retention
- More PR for the Activity Committee

Additional Suggestions March 16, 2019

- Suggestions made at the January Budget Town Hall
- Support Additional street lights, improve security, add more cameras Support with caution due to expense of LED/High-Def
- Second reader board at TL entrance support with consideration for a LED reader that would also support emergency weather/fire notifications.
 - o Consider a siren or Emergency Tone system
 - Consider up the dating global dial up phone system
- **Support** Power to Island Park, support, prefer staying under 2018 bid of \$6,000
- Support additional lighting on Streets
- improve boat launch on the big lake (will be completed prior to end of fiscal year)
- Support stock more fish! Consider Bass, Croppie, perhaps 10" trout instead of 14",
- Support. Do more to control the goose population control prior to E.coli or swimmer itch outbreak
- Update the MPC improve curb-appeal/landscaping, activity space, add conference room, increase the office space. Needs further discussion
- Support maintaining a competitive work force living wage Steeper wage trend for office/maintenance staff for retention
